

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


# Demography of the sites and our Roma samples




# Migration flows 1: GURAI




# Migration flows 2: BANIOD




# Migration flows 3: BIGHAL

# Personal migration experience and intentions to migrate




#### Patterns observed

- Differences in the timeframe of the migration experience
  - Experience before 2007, longer stays, family migration (Gurai, Baniod)
- Connection between previous experiences and future intentions
  - High intention to migrate where migration started after 2007 (Benia, Bighal)
- Differences in the number of destination countries
  - Type of networks used family network (Gurai, Benia) vs transethnic network/local community (Bighal, Hideni)

# Effects on the origin community

- Economical effect financial remittances
- Social Remittances / skills
- Local social processes
  - > Residential desegregation
  - Diversification of personal networks
  - Increasingly positive attitudes toward "successful" Roma migrants

- Social/professional remittances skills acquired abroad are valorised at home more effectively than trainings and professional reconversion courses organized by structural and other funds.

Increasingly positive attitudes toward "successful" Roma migrants


















### Further questions to address
